- **\$400.00 fee per team**
- **All players must be at least 18 years of age and out of high school**
- **Registration deadline ~
October 10, 2016 thru Friday December 16, 2016**
- **If you register late, there will be an additional \$50 fee (December 19 thru January 6, 2017. Each team will play every team once and then into one double elimination bracket. Shirts will be awarded to the team that wins the tournament only.**
- **Payment of fee holds your spot (8 team minimum)**
- **All games will be on Sundays beginning January 15, 2017**
- **Uniforms must have number on front and back (no tape). Recommend purchase of reversible type jerseys or shirts.**
- **Declare uniform color on roster. Please check when registering that no one else has the same uniform color in division.**

CITY OF NEWMAN ADULT BASKETBALL 2017

GAME

1. A game shall consist of two twenty minute halves, running clock. Stop clock timing will be used during the last two minutes of the second half. Overtime periods shall be two minutes, stop clock timing. If still tied, sudden death play will begin (first team to score wins game). All overtime periods shall begin with a jump ball.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. The team captain is the designated spokesperson for each team. The officials will only discuss problems with the team captain. Individual players must first go through their captain.
2. Players must check in at the scorers table prior to entering the game.
3. Two time outs per team per half. Time outs do not carry over from the first half to the second. Each team will be given an additional time out in overtime games.
4. Players foul out of the game on their 5th personal foul. A one and one free throw situation will take place on the 6th team foul of each half. On the 10th team foul of each half; the shooting team will get two free throws automatically.
5. A game may begin with four players but will not continue with less than four players.
6. The wearing of any type of jewelry will not be permitted (rings, bracelets, necklaces, earrings, etc). Medic alert jewelry will be permitted.
7. Team Captain's are responsible for the behavior of their players and spectators.
8. **DUNKING: There will be NO dunking or hanging on the rim or backboard during warm-ups, half-time or following completion of the game. PENALTY: Flagrant technical foul. (Two shots, ball out of bounds at Division Line; player ejected).**

ROSTERS

1. Rosters must be turned in by game time of the team's first game. Captains should list all individuals expected to play during the season, regular or back up. All players must be on the roster to be eligible to play in the league.
2. The captain must provide complete information for each player listed on the roster. Each player must read the waiver and sign the roster prior to playing his first game. Ineligible players are grounds for forfeit.
3. *Rosters will be frozen after your second game.* No changes may be made after that date unless authorized by the Recreation Department through a written request. Authorization will only be granted in the case of an injury, illness or other emergency situation causing the player to be unable to play for an extended amount of time. A replacement may also be made in the case of job relocation or dismissal. The request must be accompanied by proof of a player's inability, for example, a certified MD's verification or verification on letterhead of a dismissal or relocation.
4. **Players on the roster must be at least 18 years of age and out of high school.**
5. Any team may carry a minimum of 7 players and a maximum of 20.
6. A player must play in at least three regular season games to be eligible for the playoffs.
7. Any team member(s) on more than one roster will be considered an illegal player for the second team they take the court with within the league.

PLAYER CONDUCT

1. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
2. A player ejected from a game for any reason will sit out a minimum of the next scheduled game. Ejected players must immediately leave the court and the gym. An ejected player may not attend their suspended game.
3. Profanity deemed excessive will not be tolerated. Coaches, players, managers found guilty of such behavior will be subject to ejection from the game and must sit out the next game.
4. The Field Supervisor has authority to eject players and handle situations independently or with referees before, during and after games as necessary.
5. Continued harassment of officials, and/or scorekeepers by player, coach or fans. This includes during any breaks in the game (half-time and dead balls), and the conclusion of game maybe ejected from gym or cause their team to forfeit the game. One game automatic suspension for players and coaches.
6. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on City or School property. This rule will be strictly enforced. Any players or spectators showing signs of intoxication will be asked to leave the premises.
7. It is the responsibility of the captain and his team members to make their respective spectators aware of all rules of conduct.
8. The Recreation Supervisor has the right to disqualify any player or team from league play due to unsportsmanlike conduct.
9. The Recreation Supervisor has a right to enforce these and other rules deemed necessary to provide a safe and quality league.
10. Please do not bring food or drink (other than water) into the gymnasium. No smoking on school campus. Please make an effort to keep the facility clean so we may continue using it.

FORFEITS

1. Forfeit time is game time for all games. The officials have the right to use their own discretion before calling a forfeit.
2. A team that forfeits due to lack of eligible players will have to pay a fine \$60 to Recreation Department before their next game. If fine is not paid within the time limit, team maybe dropped from league and no refund given.

INJURIES/INSURANCE

1. City of Newman is not responsible for any injuries incurred while on City or School premises before, during or after a game or practice. The City of Newman is also not responsible for any damage to vehicles or other all teams and individuals should be commercially insured. The City of Newman provides no insurance.
2. **BLOOD RULE** - A player, coach, or official who is bleeding or has blood on his uniform shall be prohibited from participating further in the game until appropriate treatment can be administered. If medical care or treatment is administered in a reasonable length of time, the individual will not have to leave the game. The length of time that is considered reasonable is left to the official's judgment.
The official shall:
 - a) Stop the game and allow treatment if the injured player would affect the continuation of the game.
 - b) Apply the rules of the game regarding the re-entry rule.
4. If there is any form of blood showing on the uniform, whether it is fresh or not, the person must either change the uniform, or cover the area with tape.
5. Managers are requested to have available and carry to each game, a first-aid kit complete with gauze, Band-Aids, ice packs and tape. First aid is available through the Field Supervisor or Umpire.

LEAGUE STANDINGS

The league standings will be based upon the following point system:

- a) 2 points for a win, 0 points for a loss and 1 point for a forfeit.
- b) Any team with a forfeit during the regular season will automatically lose all ties.
- c) If two teams are tied with identical point totals, head to head competition will break tie.
