On March 18th, 2020, the Stanislaus County Public Health Officer offered the following guidelines for all Stanislaus County residents.

“Stay at home if possible. If you need to be out in the community, maintain social distancing of six (6) feet. Seniors or those with serious underlying medical conditions should remain at home based on public health recommendations.”

While Newman has no confirmed cases of COVID-19, the City supports the issuance of these guidelines and ask all residents to help curb the spread of COVID-19 and protect the health and safety of City residents and visitors.

“We call upon our residents to remain considerate of the larger community and do their part in confronting this challenge,” commented Mayor Bob Martina. “Adhering to the guidelines issued by our Public Health Officer will be crucial in slowing the spread of COVID-19.”

The City continues to work with the County Public Health Officer to increase the health and safety of our community, and update the public accordingly. In the meantime, the City encourages residents to continue to support our local businesses, but requests that residents refrain from gathering in large groups. Local restaurants can provide take-out food and many offer delivery service.
